## Monarch Butterfly Word Definitions

<b>Antenna</b>	The two “feelers” on the top of a butterfly’s head
<b>Caterpillar</b>	Leaf eating, worm-like larva of a butterfly or moth
<b>Chrysalis</b>	Hard-shelled pupa of moth or butterfly
<b>Endangered</b>	Species with numbers that are so few, they are at risk for extinction
<b>Habitat</b>	The natural home of an organism or group of organisms
<b>Insect</b>	Small animal that has six legs and generally one or two pairs of wings
<b>Larva</b>	The active immature form of an insect, a stage between egg and pupa
<b>Metamorphosis</b>	The process of transformation from an immature form to an adult form in two or more distinct stages
<b>Migration</b>	Seasonal movement of animals from one region to another
<b>Molt</b>	The shedding of feathers, skin, or hair to make way for new growth
<b>Monarch</b>	A large migratory orange and black butterfly that is largely found in North America
<b>Nectar</b>	A sugary fluid secreted by flowers to encourage pollination by insects
<b>Pupae</b>	An insect in its inactive immature form between larva and adult
<b>Pollinator</b>	An animal that moves pollen from the anther of a flower to the stigma of a flower
<b>Proboscis</b>	In many insects an elongated sucking mouthpart that is typically tubular and flexible
